#### SURVEY OF AVAILABLE STATISTICS

THE survey of available statistics, made in 1937, has not been revised. It may therefore not represent accurately, in every detail, the present situation. Unforeseen obstacles delayed the completion of the Committee's report, and rather than delay it even longer by attempting a revision of this chapter to bring it fully up to date the Committee offers it as originally prepared. We believe however that it is substantially accurate with respect to its main features even today (November 1939).
