

## **The Council of Economic Advisers is Recruiting Staff Economists**

The Council of Economic Advisers (CEA) is beginning our recruiting process for Staff Economists for the 2010-2011 academic year. The CEA provides the President with objective economic analysis and advice on the development and implementation of a wide range of domestic and international economic policy issues. Staff Economists are typically Ph.D. students on leave from top programs, and are integral members of the CEA team. They conduct advanced statistical analysis, contribute to reports distributed throughout the Administration and to Congress, and play a key role in producing the President's daily economic briefing.

Staff Economists must be U.S. citizens and may not also be citizens of another country. Most Staff Economists work at the Council beginning in the summer and stay for a full academic year. We are also looking to add one or two additional Staff Economists to our staff immediately, with the option of staying for the remainder of the current academic year, the full 2010 calendar year, or longer.
