The candidates are expected to have strong statistical and data analysis skills and good writing skills, and to participate in data analysis and manuscript writing. Demonstrated ability to perform statistical analysis, manage large datasets, and write manuscripts and other documents of a technical and scientific nature and a strong interest in interdisciplinary work combining genetics and social sciences are highly desirable. The position offers opportunities to interact and work with several leading scholars and researchers in the areas of health economics, genetics, and health services research.
