The second paper, co-authored with Thomas Chemmanur and Karen Simonyan, investigates the *role of management quality on innovation in venture-backed entrepreneurial firms*. The third paper (single-authored) assesses the effect of agency issues on the financing constraints of REITs. It was also presented at various prestigious conferences and has won the Best Ph.D. Paper Award at the 2011 European Real Estate Society Annual Meetings, has been nominated for the Best Paper at the 2011 Swiss Doctoral Workshop, and has also been presented at the 2014 American Real Estate and Urban Economic Association Policy Meetings. I hope that the above serves as a strong signal of my ability and commitment to conduct high quality and independent research.
