RE: Tax-Deferred Annuity Plan

The Bureau has Tax-Deferred Annuity Plan (TDA Plan). All Bureau employees are eligible to participate in this plan, which provides a tax efficient way to save for retirement.

To participate in this plan, an employee enters into a salary reduction agreement with the Bureau. The employee's taxable income is reduced by the amount selected, which the Bureau then deposits into a TIAA/CREF annuity contract, and/or into a custodial retirement account in a Vanguard mutual fund. Earnings in TDA accounts are tax-deferred. The Summary Plan Description describes in more detail the operation and features of the plan.

The IRS contribution limit for TDA plans for 2010 is \$16,500. If you are 50 or older in 2010, you are also eligible to make additional catch-up contributions of up to \$5,500.00. These IRS limits are combined limits that apply to all your elective deferral amounts. If you make contributions to more that one employer's plan during the year (e.g., another 403(b) or a 401(k) plan) your contributions to these plans are aggregated with your elective contributions to the Bureau's TDA Plan for purposes of these limits. I strongly advise you speak to a representative at either Vanguard (tel #800-523-1188), or TIAA-CREF (tel #800-842-2888) before you decide how much you would like to contribute to the TDA plan.
