Professor Michael Weber is looking for a full-time research assistant for a period of at least one year but ideally two years. The preferred start date is July 1, 2018, although we are willing to accommodate an earlier or later start. Applications will be evaluated on a rolling basis, but all applications submitted by March 1, 2018, will be given full consideration. Professor Weber is interested in finding hard-working people who like learning new skills and want to collaborate closely with a faculty member who is interested in their skill development. Professor Weber researches policy-relevant topics in monetary economics, macroeconomics, and finance. His research has been published in the *American Economic Review*, the *Review of Economic Studies*, and the *Journal of Financial Economics*.

The ideal candidate will have (i) a strong quantitative background, (ii) strong computer skills including programming (ideally SAS, Stata, Matlab), (iii) strong writing skills, (iv) the ability to work independently to solve problems, and (v) a long-term interest in pursuing research in economics and finance.

Background in economics or finance is a plus, but not necessary—we welcome candidates with strong technical backgrounds and strong writing skills who are looking for more exposure to economics. We pay an annual salary of \$48,000 and providing standard benefits such as health insurance.
