Professors Michael Weber, Thomas Rauter, and João Granja seek a Research Professional for a period of at least one year but ideally two years. Research Professionals work with faculty to collect data, maintain databases, conduct statistical analysis, and provide other support associated with faculty research. The three professors research policy-relevant topics in macroeconomics, finance, FinTech, financial intermediation, banking, applied microeconomics, and accounting. Their research has been published in the *American Economic Review*, the *Review of Economic Studies*, the *Journal of Finance*, the *Journal of Financial Economics*, and the *Journal of Accounting Research*.

The ideal candidate will have (i) a strong quantitative background, (ii) very strong computer skills including programming, (iii) strong writing skills, (iv) the ability to work independently to solve problems, and (v) a long-term interest in pursuing research in economics and finance. Background in economics or finance is a plus, but not necessary—candidates with strong technical backgrounds and writing skills who are looking for more exposure to economics are welcome to apply.
