#### **Job Description**

We are looking for a highly skilled and motivated individual to work as a full-time research assistant for a period of one or two years, **starting July 1, 2026**. The researcher will be based at the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia and will work in close collaboration with Professors Castillo, Yildirim, and their coauthors. The job will involve research in applied microeconomics, focusing on projects on the digital economy, transportation and urban economics, and industrial organization.

#### **Required Qualifications**

The ideal candidate will have:

1. A strong quantitative background, including a BA/BS in economics, statistics, or another quantitative field like computer science or engineering.
2. Strong programming skills using AI in conjunction with R, Python, Matlab, Julia, Stata or a similar language.
3. The ability to work independently to solve problems.
4. Strong communication skills.
5. A long-term interest in pursuing research in economics. Previous Penn pre-docs have been successfully placed in highly-ranked PhD programs and eventually into faculty positions.
6. Experience with research in economics is a plus, but not a strict requirement.
