# Appendix E

## World Imports Excluding U.S. Exports and Imports

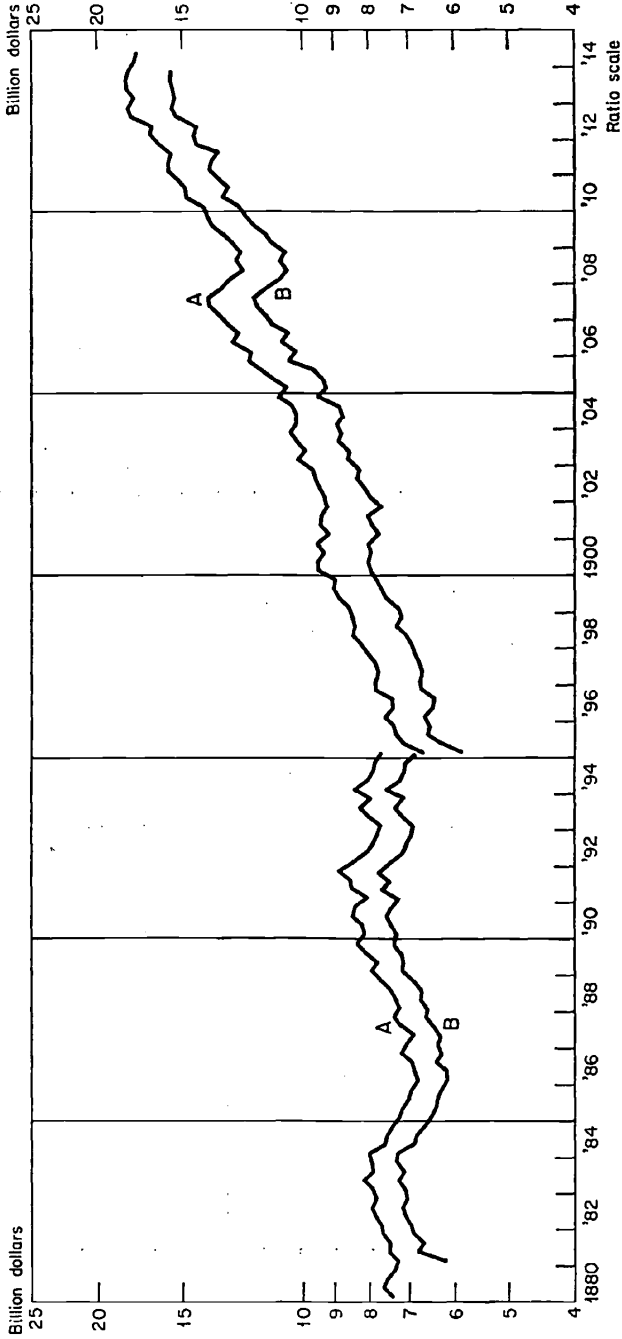

The charts below provide comparisons of world imports excluding the sum of U.S. exports and U.S. imports (i.e., total imports of foreign countries from each other) with the series used in this study: world imports excluding U.S. imports.

World imports excluding U.S. exports and imports for 1880-1914 (Chart E-1) have been derived from seasonally unadjusted series. The seasonal adjustment has been applied to the final series.

For 1920-59, however, the seasonally adjusted component series (Tables A-1 and A-2) have been used to derive seasonally adjusted world imports excluding U.S. imports and exports (Charts E-2 and E-3).

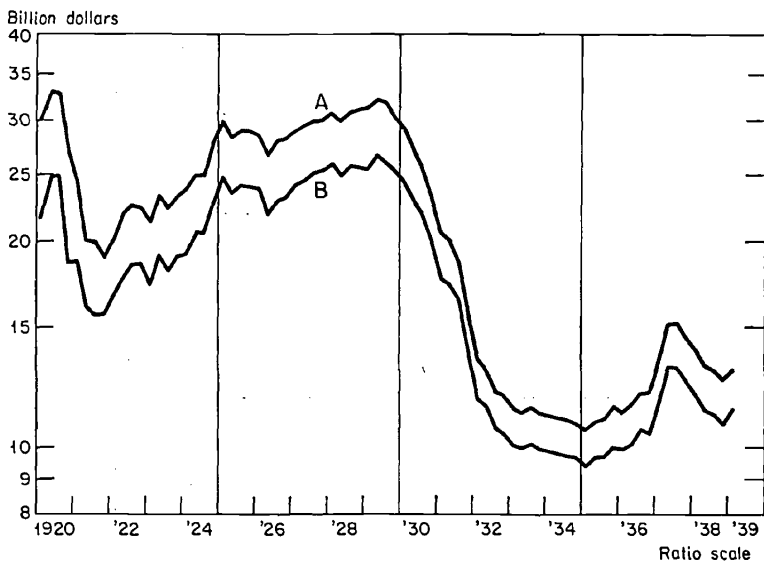

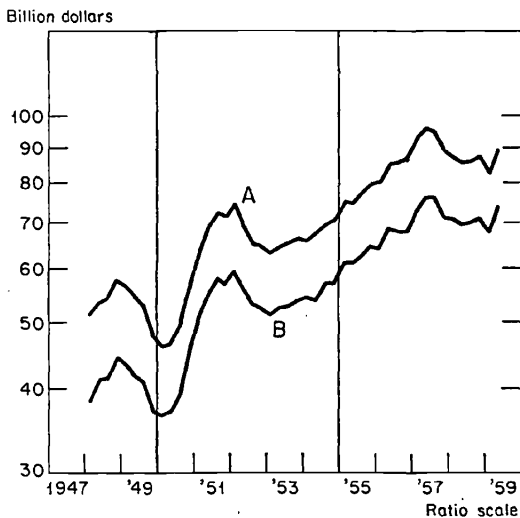
#### Comparison of Two Series on World Imports, 1920-39
