Appendix E

EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT IN ISRAEL

THE PURPOSE OF this appendix is to establish the ranking of educational attainment among the four groups in the population of Israel: Euro-American newcomers (EN), Euro-American veterans (EV), Afro-Asian newcomers (AN), and Afro-Asian veterans (AV). (This rankings is used in the second part of Chapter 6.) The relevant findings on this educational attainment, shown by per cent distribution for the year 1954 in the 1959–60 *Statistical Abstract of Israel*, are presented in Table E.1. The levels of schooling were estimated on the basis of the following estimated values:
