## Appendix D

### BASIC INCOME DATA AND SUBSIDIARY BREAKDOWNS

Tables 38 through 41 are reproduced directly from Simon Kuznets, *National Income and Its Composition* (National Bureau of Economic Research, 1941) or from worksheets underlying that study. They provide a breakdown of the income totals shown in Table 4. They show, in addition, the basic annual material underlying the interpolations carried out in Chapter V. The figures are before adjustment for the exclusion of inventory profits and losses, and profits and losses on the sale of capital assets; nor has any adjustment been made to place depreciation on any other basis than book value. Owing to the change in the *Statistics of Income* classification which occurred in 1934, two figures are presented for that year for items derived from this source, the first comparable with earlier, the second with later, years. In Table 4 the alternative values for 1934 have been averaged.

Table 42 provides a breakdown of the quarterly series for long term income in Finance, Service and Miscellaneous shown in Table 15. This material is given for the benefit of those who wish to remove imputed rentals from the income totals quarter by quarter, in order to obtain series which correspond more closely to the concept of cash income.
